Membership Privileges

As a member of the Heritage Club you will receive an invitation to the annual Heritage Club Dinner hosted by the YMCA every October, recognition in the YMCA Annual Report and the Heritage Club program, membership memento, and courtesy mailings of YMCA publications.

Membership Qualifications

- An outright gift to the YMCA Endowment Fund of cash, securities, property or other marketable assets.
- Naming the YMCA of San Diego County or one of its branches to receive a bequest in one's will or trust.
- Naming the YMCA of San Diego County or one of its branches as a beneficiary of life insurance.
- Naming the YMCA of San Diego County or one of its branches as a beneficiary of an IRA or other qualified retirement account.
- Naming the YMCA of San Diego County or one of its branches as a beneficiary of a Charitable Remainder Trust, Charitable Gift Annuity, Pooled Income Fund, or a gift of a personal residence with a retained life estate.
- Create a Named Fund on behalf of the YMCA of San Diego County general Endowment Fund or specific branch or program. Named Funds may also be established in honor of a loved one.
